Harley Brakes Harley have improved the performance of their stock brakes in recent years, but this still leaves many older bikes with less than ideal brakes. Most aftermarket brakes on offer give superior quality braking to stock brakes and even the most recent models will benefit from a brake change, especially the front wheel calipers. If you are considering changing your brakes and as a general rule you can safely install

Single 4 pot on front wheel with 11.5in rotor

Single 6 pot on front wheel with 13in rotor

Double 4 pot on front wheel with 11.5in rotor-requires larger bore brake master cylinder

Single 6 pot on front wheel with 11.5in rotor

Single 6 pot on front wheel with 13in rotor

Single 4 pot on rear wheel with 11.5in rotor

Most braking takes place on the front wheel and putting too much braking on the rear wheel can make your bike unsafe, especially on wet roads Changing your brake hose to braided versions will also improve the quality of braking. All calipers listed here are similar in braking quality and vary mostly in appearance, finish and fitment.
